BYOD – All year levels

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) supports the delivery of 21st century learning. BYOD requires students to use their personally owned laptops to access the school's network.

Clifton State High School is now 100% BYOD.

Before acquiring a device to use at school the parent/guardian and student should be aware of the school's minimum specifications. These can be found on the school website along with Participation Agreement Forms, BYOD Student Charter, BYOD Equity Policy and Agreement and BYOD Responsible Use Policy.

Students with existing 1:1 devices may continue to use them at the same annual cost as 2018 with the understanding that these devices will not be repaired or replaced at the end of life.

NOTE: There are a limited number of devices, more than 5 years old, which can be made available to students / families who meet the financial assistance criteria.

What the scheme does NOT provide

- ☞ Personal note pads and workbooks in which students will write and basic stationery.
- ☞ Payment to School of Distance Education (Distance Education elective subjects). Non refundable item once resources ordered.
- ☞ Work Experience Placement, School Based Traineeships / Apprenticeships.
- ☞ Any materials over or above basic curriculum needs will need to be purchased. The student may then take the product home. Payment is due before the student takes the item home.

Government contribution:

The Government Textbook and Resource Allowance supports the concept and keeps it at a low levy by allocating money to the school to complement the school scheme. These Allowances are \$127 per year for students in years 7-10, and \$276 for those in senior years.

The following conditions apply to the scheme.

- ☞ Students will supply their own personal requirements.
- ☞ Books issued to students are to be kept in good condition.
- ☞ Students may be responsible for up to the full cost of books that are negligently damaged or lost before any further issues can be made.
- ☞ The office should be immediately notified of the loss of any textbook.
- ☞ All textbooks provided under the scheme remain the property of the scheme and must be returned when a student leaves or at the end of the school year.
- ☞ All scheme monies received by the school on behalf of the Parents' and Citizens' Association will be banked in the school's general account, which is subject to annual audit.
- ☞ If a student starts at the school after first term, the fee is reduced on a pro-rata basis.
- ☞ If a student leaves the school having paid the charge, a pro-rata refund will be made. The refund is based on the full charge being Government Allowance and parent/caregiver charge, less the cost of consumed materials and/or the cost of replacing lost or damaged textbooks.
- ☞ Books and resources provided under the scheme cannot be issued to students whose parents/caregivers choose not to participate.
- ☞ **The principal may refuse to admit a student to the scheme if there are hire payments overdue from the previous year.**

Parents / caregivers who do not wish to participate in the scheme should inform the school office.

These parents/caregivers will receive a cheque from the school to the value of the Allowance for each of their children. However, they are expected to provide all necessary textbooks and other resources for their student/s. Attached to this document is a booklist (subject to change) of texts that students utilize in their studies, should you wish to purchase textbooks personally.

Please be aware that the school will not take responsibility for student learning through lack of resources if you choose not to participate in the scheme.

ARRANGEMENTS FOR PAYMENT


Please sign the Resource Hire form and return it to the school by 21/01/2019
