Whole School

- Improve student outcomes in the area of literacy, with particular focus on higher order thinking with reading and writing by 5% across the school using Tactical Teaching.
- Provide professional development of staff in the areas of reading, writing, and pedagogy.
- Increase the percentage of students in the Year 7 -10 "C" or better standard in English, Mathematics and Science by 5% by the end of 2022
- Improve management of student attendance (Target: 90%)
- Improve student higher order thinking skills through the STEAM Program
- Further develop Whole School Support Program through additional teacher aides and positive behaviour program
- Staff support to align the curriculum from Y7 to Y12 with a ATAR and QCE focus.
- Improve reporting of bullying in school and Wellbeing with Stymie and Elavate
- Steam collabaration across cluster of 7 primary and one high school.

Junior Secondary

- Increase the proportion of students making Individual Relative Gains for students in Year 7 to 9 for all strand areas of NAPLAN (Target: increase by 5%)
- Increase the proportion of students in Year 7 & 9 at or above the NMS in the reading and writing strand of NAPLAN (Target: increase by 5%)
- 8% of cohort in Yr 7 & 9 in the U2Bs for NAPLAN Writing and Reading strand

Senior Secondary

Increase students attaining QCE,QCIA, ATAR and VET qualifications (Target 100%).

- Employing Teacher Aides to provide in class support to students who have learning difficulties, disabilities, an indigenous background or EAL/D
- Employ an extra Teacher Aide to provide focussed suport to students with learning difficulties, assist with the collection of diagnostic testing results and assist with the data collection and intervention
- Employ Senior School Industry Liaison Officer to assist with QCE attainment & VET qualifications,
 Apprenticeships and Traineeships (Target: 100% of students leave at end of Year 12 with QCE or Vet Qual)
- Monitor and improve student attendance via tracking in ID Attend (Target: 90%)
- Embedding of the STEAM program (Target Cluster Steam collaboration 6 Primary and 1 secondary school)
- Online Progressive Assessment Testing to provide up to date diagnostic data for staff to differentiate for diverse needs
- Staff development program to build capacity in the areas of writing, pedagogy and data analysis
- Positive wellbeing program supporting 100% of students and building relationships.
