### CO-OPERATIVE RESOURCES HIRE SCHEME 2023

The purpose of this scheme is to ensure that all students have the necessary resources for their education, and to save parents / care givers money and the need to shop for school books.

#### What the scheme provides

In return for a fee of **\$250.00** the school scheme provides:

Hire of all textbooks and class sets	School Planner / School Diary
Basic materials for the Arts and Technology	Subsidy of essential / curriculum excursions
All printed class notes	Hire of School blazers / Equine shirts
Materials used for classroom projects	Instruments for use in Music (excluding Instrumental Music)
Hire of Library Resources	BYOD connection fee

The school scheme provides this package for a set fee. It is not available in part.

#### Additional Subject Specific Fees:

- Food & Fibre Production:** To allow students to cook and sew, the school will provide basic pantry ingredients or materials. (Items beyond these basic consumables need to be supplied by students)

- Certificate II Hospitality:** To allow students to cook, the school will provide basic pantry. (Items beyond these basic consumables need to be supplied by students)

- Visual Arts:** (The school covers general consumable art supplies such as paint, brushes, paper and ink etc. Materials (eg Canvases) and beyond general consumables need to be supplied by students. It is very likely in Senior Art subjects that students will require additional resources.)

Yr 11 - \$365 (must be paid in full by 02/12/22 for enrolment to be processed with external provider – no refunds available)
- Instrumental Music:**  
Yr 7-12 (Fee) - \$40      Yr 7-12 (Hire) - \$40

**All fees are subject to Annual Review**

#### What the scheme does NOT provide

- Personal note pads and workbooks in which students will write and basic stationery.
- Payment to School of Distance Education (Distance Education elective subjects). Non refundable item once resources ordered.
- Work Experience Placement, School Based Traineeships / Apprenticeships.
- Any materials over or above basic curriculum needs will need to be purchased. The student may then take the product home. Payment is due before the student takes the item home.

### The following conditions apply to the scheme

- ☞ Students will supply their own personal requirements.
- ☞ Books issued to students are to be kept in good condition.
- ☞ Students may be responsible for up to the full cost of books that are negligently damaged or lost before any further issues can be made.
- ☞ The Resource Centre should be immediately notified of the loss of any textbook.
- ☞ All textbooks provided under the scheme remain the property of the scheme and must be returned when a student leaves or at the end of the school year.
- ☞ All scheme monies received by the school on behalf of the Parents' and Citizens' Association will be banked in the school's general account, which is subject to annual audit.
- ☞ If a student starts at the school after first term, the fee is reduced on a pro-rata basis.
- ☞ If a student leaves the school having paid the charge, a pro-rata refund will be made. The refund is based on the full charge being Government Allowance and parent/caregiver charge, less the cost of consumed materials and/or the cost of replacing lost or damaged textbooks.
- ☞ Books and resources provided under the scheme cannot be issued to students whose parents/caregivers choose not to participate.
- ☞ **The Principal may refuse to admit a student to the scheme if there are hire payments overdue from the previous year.**
